We will continue to keep the expectations, as well as the safety and well-being of the members in mind when planning and weighing these decisions. We are constantly reviewing updated information from the CDC and will continue to base our decisions and recommendations made by state, county and local authorities.

After completely disinfecting and sanitizing the Outdoor Bar and Aquatic Center, continuously monitoring the health and availability of our staff, and carefully planning every detail, we will be reopening both of these areas.

The Outdoor Bar will reopen on Saturday, July 18<sup>th</sup> at 11:00am. The pool will also reopen on Saturday at noon. Both the Outdoor Bar and swimming pool will operate under new rules and regulations that are listed below. We ask that all members carefully read the reopening regulations and continue to comply with all Greenbriar rules and regulations. Thank you again for all of your cooperation and understanding.

### **Outdoor Bar Reopening Rules and Regulations**

The outdoor Bar has been completely disinfected and sanitized and will reopen on Saturday, July 18<sup>th</sup> at 11 am. The Outdoor Bar will operate under the following Rules and Regulations to ensure the safety and well-being of our members and staff.

- Hours of Operation: Tuesday thru Sunday 11:00am – 11:00pm
- A maximum of 8 members will be allowed to sit around the Bar at any given time. Additional bar stools will be removed.

- Members may not stand at or gather around the Bar
- Members will be encouraged to use the high top tables that are located within the bar structure. They will be strategically placed to allow proper social distancing
- The rail overlooking the putting green will be available to a maximum of 6 members at any given time. Please do not gather in large groups and respect your fellow members while enjoying the entire Bar area
- Servers will deliver all food and beverage to the high top tables and rail
- Bar stools, high top tables and rail will be sanitized between uses
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the Bar. Everyone is encouraged to use hand sanitizer upon arrival
- Nobody under 21 years of age is permitted within the confines of the Outdoor Bar structure
- No guests will be allowed at the Outdoor Bar. Guests will be allowed in the Trophy room, Osage, on the Terrace and at designated patio tables
- Snacks mix, popcorn and nuts will not be available
- If you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms please refrain from visiting the Club. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

## NEW

**Saturday, July 18th and Sunday, July 19<sup>th</sup> the pool will be open from noon till 6 pm**

- The pool capacity is set to 85 people including staff.
- Members **will not** need to make reservations
- Members must wear a mask upon entry and whenever social distancing is not possible.
- Members must enter through the gate near the diving boards and exit through the gate near the outdoor bar.
- Guests will not be allowed at this time.
- Upon entering, members will scan the QR code on their phone (iPhones you just use your camera) and fill out the Google Form with their name, member number, and how many people are attending. A lifeguard can do it from their phone or write it down if a member is unable to.

- Members may come for part or all of a session time. If the maximum capacity is met, we will ask members to limit their time to 2 hours.
- Members **must** inform the guard at the exit that they are leaving and not returning to ensure sanitation.
- Lounge chairs and furniture will be strategically placed by staff to meet social distancing demands. Furniture may not be moved by members. Low chairs will be available for members to move around the pool and use if no lounge chairs are available.
- Children under 12 years old must be supervised by an adult at all times.

### **Members Pool Rules and Regulations**

- Members who are experiencing any of the following symptoms are required to stay home: fever, cough, trouble breathing, body aches, sore throat or loss of taste or smell. We also ask members not to enter the pool area or clubhouse if they have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past fourteen days.
- St. Louis County Public Health Department directive requires members to wear face masks while on the pool deck when social distancing is not possible. No masks are required while in the pool or eating/drinking.
- Members must practice social distancing at all times. Social distancing is defined by health organizations as maintaining at least six feet between individuals at all times.
- All foot traffic will flow in one direction and be clearly marked. All members must sign in with an attendant / lifeguard upon arrival.
- Members must bring their own towels.
- No more than three families will be able to access the baby pool at this time.
- The boys and girls locker rooms will be open. Lockers are not to be used. Children must be accompanied by an adult when using the restrooms.
- Maximum occupancy in children's locker rooms is four. The restrooms will be disinfected and sanitized frequently.
- Members should fold their lounge chair down before they leave, in order to signal to the "porter" it is ready to be sanitized.

- All previously existing swimming pool and surrounding area rules as well as dress codes are still in place and will be strictly enforced. Swimming pool rules can be found on page nine and ten of the 2020 Greenbriar Membership Roster.

### **Additional Requirements and Safety Measures For Pool and Patio Employees**

- Pool water chemical balance must be monitored and tested no less than once every two hours of operation and prior to opening each day to ensure adherence to the requirements of the St. Louis County Public Water Recreation Facilities Code.

- If water does not meet code specifications the Pool Manager on duty must immediately close the facility and it must remain closed until such time as code requirements can be restored and maintained.

- Signage pertaining to social distancing, showing symptoms of coronavirus, being respectful and mindful of others, washing and sanitizing hands, and use of PPE will be clearly displayed on the patio, pool deck, and employee break areas. Signs will be strategically placed to ensure safety, and help enforce rules and guidelines. Managers may politely reference a sign if a situation dictates such action.

- Hands Free Sanitation stations will be available at the entrance gate of the pool and on the patio for membership and staff use.

- The General Manager or Pool Manager may close the Greenbriar Aquatic Center any time that any part of the “Phase 3” Operational Plan cannot be accomplished; including, but not limited to, lack of hand washing materials or facilities, lack of PPE, lack of social distancing, or inability to meet pool water chemical balance requirements. The General Manager can reopen once operators are capable of carrying out all parts of the plan.

- If we are unable to safely staff the pool, adjustments to the hours may be made.
