

**Pool Opening  
Phase II**

The Greenbriar Aquatic Center will operate under guidelines and regulations known as “Pool Opening Phase II” until further notice.

The pool will be monitored daily by a Pool or Club Manager (non-lifeguard). The assigned manager will strictly enforce the policies and procedures documented in “Phase II”.

Maximum Occupancy (including staff) on pool deck or in pool is set at 75 individuals.

Members will be allowed to reserve a “time slot” based on the daily schedule below.

- **Reservations are family members only (8 maximum per visit)**
- **To ensure maximum membership enjoyment no guests will be allowed at this time.**
- **Members’ parents and grandchildren are welcome.**
- **Members may designate a caregiver, babysitter, or nanny to accompany and supervise their children while at the pool. Designated caregivers must be at least eighteen years old, and are required to comprehend and comply with all pool and clubhouse rules.**

**How to Reserve a Time Slot**

- The link can be found on the Greenbriar website and the Greenbriar app.
- All pool reservations can be made up to one week in advance.
- Reservations can be made for lap swimming from 7:00 am to 9:00 am in thirty minute increments. Members may sign up for two slots if they would like to swim for an hour.
- There will be four (4) open swim sessions daily. During each session there will be 75 available reservation slots. When making a family reservation be sure to claim a reservation spot for each family member that will be visiting the pool.
- Please only sign up for one pool session a day.

## Members Pool Rules and Regulations

1. Members who are experiencing any of the following symptoms are required to stay home: fever, cough, trouble breathing, body aches, sore throat or loss of taste or smell. We also ask members not to enter the pool area or clubhouse if they have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past fourteen days.
2. St. Louis County Public Health Department directive requires members to wear face masks while on the pool deck. No masks are required while in the pool or eating/drinking.
3. Members must practice social distancing at all times. Social distancing is defined by health organizations as maintaining at least six feet between individuals at all times.
4. Lounge chairs and furniture will be strategically placed by staff to meet social distancing demands. Furniture may not be moved by members. Members may request a specific number of chairs grouped together to accommodate their family.
5. Children under twelve years old must be accompanied by an adult family member, and supervised at all times.
6. Members must enter through the gate near the diving boards and exit through the gate near the outdoor bar. All foot traffic will flow in one direction and be clearly marked. All members must sign in with an attendant/lifeguard upon arrival.
7. Members must bring their own towels.
8. No more than three families will be able to access the baby pool at this time. Please specify during reservation process if you are only interested in the baby pool.
9. Snack Bar info:
  - The Snack Bar will remain closed.
  - A disposable Patio/Kids Menu will be available. Candy, chips and slushies will be available on request and listed on menu.
10. The boys and girls locker rooms will be open. Lockers are not to be used. Children must be accompanied by an adult when using the restrooms. Maximum occupancy in children's locker rooms is four. The restrooms will be disinfected and sanitized frequently.
11. Members need to sign out with an attendant or lifeguard when exiting the pool facility.
12. Members should fold their lounge chair down before they leave to signal to the "porter" it is ready to be sanitized.
13. Members with strollers or individuals who can't use stairs may exit through the entrance gate.
14. All previously existing swimming pool and surrounding area rules as well as dress codes are still in place and will be strictly enforced. Swimming pool rules can be found on page nine and ten of the 2020 Greenbriar Membership Roster.

### **Additional Requirements and Safety Measures For Pool and Patio Employees**

- 1. Pool water chemical balance must be monitored and tested no less than once every two hours of operation and prior to opening each day to ensure adherence to the requirements of the St. Louis County Public Water Recreation Facilities Code.**
- 2. If water does not meet code specifications the Pool Manager on duty must immediately close the facility and it must remain closed until such time as code requirements can be restored and maintained.**
- 3. Signage pertaining to social distancing, showing symptoms of corona virus, being respectful and mindful of others, washing and sanitizing hands, and use of PPE will be clearly displayed on the patio, pool deck, and employee break areas. Signs will be strategically placed to ensure safety, and help enforce rules and guidelines. Managers may politely reference a sign if a situation dictates such action.**
- 4. Hands Free Sanitation stations will be available at the entrance gate of pool and on the patio for membership and staff use.**
- 5. The General Manager or Pool Manager may close the Greenbriar Aquatic Center any time that any part of the "Phase II" Operational Plan cannot be accomplished; including, but not limited to, lack of hand washing materials or facilities, lack of PPE, lack of social distancing, or unable to meet pool water chemical balance requirements. The General Manager can reopen once operators are capable of carrying out all parts of the plan.**
